

My Prayer for You:

First, I pray that the Holy Spirit would ignite your hearts to love and to peace. That your house and your children would feel the presence of God and know that He resides there. Let Your presence, Lord so possess each heart that they would know that You are here.

Second, I pray that the love of Christ inhabits every abode under the sound of my voice. May each husband love as Christ loves and protect his wife as Christ loves and protects the church. May each wife draw near to her husband so that the two serve God in tandem as the Bible directs. May those who have no spouse be drawn by the power of God to love Christ as Christ also loves and that Christ become the husbandman of each member male or female.

Third, my prayer for you is that unity would abound in the place where you rest. That every discord and every argument be met with fresh fire for the Word of God to silence that discord. May the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God be the final answer to the questions in your hearts and that both would be contented with Christ as the final authority to life and to godliness.

Fourth, I pray that nothing hidden, nothing seen, nothing thought or nothing intended would come between them and You. That no matter what the issue that understanding and knowledge would rule as Christ has forgiven, so shall they. As Jeremiah prophesied *“Is not Your Word like fire and like a hammer that shatters the rock.”* Nothing present or intended will stand against the Word of God. Your Word will burn out the dross and smash the very mountain that stands in the way of relationships. I pray that relationships be restored and rebuilt to where once love abounded. I pray this in Jesus’ name.

Fifth, I pray that the Word of God that since you received it as Paul wrote in 1Thessalonians 2; you have accepted it not as the words of men, but for what it really is...the Word of God performing in you who believe His very work in your lives. That once you thought things would never change for good would be brought to satisfaction in you to God and that which was always kept secret to you in His Word would come alive in your hearts to joy.

Sixth, I pray as Paul prayed that the God of peace Himself would sanctify you entirely and that your spirit, soul and body be preserved complete

without blame. That as the enemy of your soul in times past has brought accusation against you, that through the Spirit of God you might be clean to stand before God as a righteous son or daughter and that until the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Seventh, I pray as Jude wrote under the unction of the Spirit of God that you be built up in your most holy faith, praying in the Spirit. That you keep yourselves in the love of God, awaiting anxiously the mercy that has been granted you through the grace of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ to eternal life. Now my prayer is to the One who is able to keep you from stumbling in this life and make you stand in the presence of His glory with great joy, be glad and rejoice for you are and have been created for such a time as this.

Eighth, once again, I pray that no weapon formed against you by any man, evil presence or by intended thought would come near you to harm, to take your place or to leave you faithless. Stand strong in the power of His might, not moved, or divided, but one strong unit in faith and perseverance. Push out doubt and fear and may the love of God inhabit those places left empty.

Ninth, I pray this morning Lord that the destiny of these homes and those who inhabit them be written in the Lamb's Book of Life. That each family member be overcome by the Spirit of God and begin to stand in that place You have made for them. That those outside the faith would come in and those who are in faith would come to greater clarity in the Word of God, so that nothing would be impossible for them that believe.

Tenth, and finally, I pray deliverance for all those in here and out there today from care, from worry, from fear, from anxiety, from depression, oppression, over sickness, over the thoughts and weight of sin that can so easily beset us. Renew these minds in here today to great things. Put in our hearts a joy and contentment that we have never experienced before and let it flow from person to person in here until all have been covered by it and that they know this is the work of the Spirit of God in us today. All these things I pray in the name of the only begotten Son of God, the way to eternal life, the giver of life, the sacrifice for our sins, the One who when it was accomplished said; "It Is Finished" and who brought hope to sinful man that they might be saved, in that name, in Jesus' name the name above all names, we pray today,
